

Malangen

Ski trek to Kvannfjellet (1043m above sea level)

Degree of difficulty: The first part is reasonably easy, but if you make the summit ascent it can be demanding and challenging.

Distance: about 3 km

Equipment: Food, seating pad, warm clothes, ski wax, sun cream/sun glasses and camera

Directions: Follow the dark blue route on the map. The ski trek starts at Malangen Brygger, where you turn left onto the main road. Turn right at the first intersection in the direction of Fjellbygda then continue for about 4 km until you reach another intersection where you turn left. Continue driving up until you see a sign on your right hand side reading “Fjellskardalen”. Drive right to the end of the road. You can park your car here (the dark blue point on the map marks this point). Follow the power lines around 1 km then a further 2 km to the right in the direction of the mountain Kvannfjellet. This is a great place to make a base and enjoy yourself in the sun (see pink point). If you wish to continue right to the summit, continue upwards for a further 1 km. The ski tracks are not prepared and the trails are not marked so just follow the map.

Other tips:

- It's also possible to ski up Kvannfjellet from the Røyken clubhouse at Fjellbygda (light blue floodlit trail). Keep going upwards when you reach the end of the trail.
- If you want a fantastic view towards Tromsø, follow the blue striped line – about 4 km.
- From the valley Fjellskardalen, it's possible to ski across the Malangen Peninsula. Follow the dark blue striped line to the green main route.
- Remember the mountain code!
